A workshop on “The European Corporation in the XXI Century: Changing Ownership and Governance Patterns” will be held in Barcelona, Spain, on 20-22 May 2019. The workshop is part of the activities of **the Jean Monnet Network “Corporate Governance and European Integration”** (www.cgeui.eu).

The workshop will be open to the members of the CGEUI network as well as any interested researchers currently not involved in the CGEUI network activities. The theme of the workshop is **The European Corporation in the XXI Century: Changing Ownership and Governance Patterns**. Papers in all areas of research on European ownership and corporate governance transformation since the launch of the European Single Market and reforms in Eastern Europe are welcome.

Abstracts (up to 500 words) should be submitted via email to evgeni.peev@wu.ac.at by **1 March 2019**. Please state “Submission for CGEUI Workshop on the European Corporation in the XXI Century: Changing Ownership and Governance Patterns May 2019” in the subject line of your email. The papers will be selected based on the extended abstracts. The authors of the accepted papers will be notified by **10 March 2019**. The complete papers should be submitted by **15 May 2019**.

The workshop will also include a one-and-a-half-day **training seminar** on 21-22 May.

The workshop will be also open to PhD students and early-career researchers (ECRs). The seminar will include presentations by the PhDs and ECRs, contributions by experienced researchers, and plenty of opportunities for discussion.
